**In-Use Off-Road Large Spark-Ignition Engine Fleet Regulation (LSI Fleet Regulation)** requires fleet operators to conduct a baseline inventory of their fleet and then comply with fleet average emission standards. **Special provisions and exemptions may be applicable for your agricultural operation.**

### ***Sonoma County Farm Bureau and California Air Resources Board (CARB)***

are providing a unique training opportunity for fleets to learn about the current and proposed amendments to the LSI Fleet Regulation. The public comment portion will address the proposed additional reporting requirements, labeling requirements and other changes that will be decided upon in spring 2016.
