

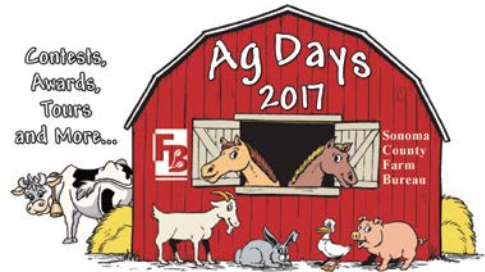

Things to Know:

- Displays and booths in the Lyttle Cow Palace are to be set up between 4 and 6 p.m. on Monday, March 13 (overnight security is provided) or Tuesday, March 14 beginning at 6:30 a.m. Booths must be set up by 8:30 a.m. All vehicles are to be parked away from the Lyttle Cow Palace and barn area.
- Booths must be staffed from 9:00 a.m. to noon on Tuesday, March 14 and Wednesday, March 15. Exhibitors are invited to the Awards Dinner at 5:30 p.m. Tuesday, March 14 at the Sonoma County Fairgrounds. Each group will be given 4 free tickets. Additional tickets may be purchased at \$15 each. Advance purchase and RSVP required.
